

Most communication from MAB to the appraiser will either be done by mail or email. It is vital to have a correct e-mail address and updated phone number.




Left side after you have logged in:


If all 28 hours (including the current 7 hour USPAP Update Course) has been loaded you are compliant

All licensed and certified appraisers are required by Rule 5.1 to complete 28 hours of continuing education to include a seven (7) hour USPAP update course.

All Education must be Approved by the Board in order to count as CE. It is the appraiser's responsibility to verify that the course taken has been approved by the Mississippi Appraisal Board. Rule 5.2(3)

Licensees are instructed to contact the educational provider to verify course has been approved.

NOTE: ANY LICENSED OR CERTIFIED APPRAISER THAT IS NOT IN COMPLIANCE WITH CE BY THEIR EXPIRATION DATE WILL AUTOMATICALLY BE PLACED INACTIVE THE FOLLOWING DAY. THIS INCLUDES BEING PLACED INACTIVE ON THE NATIONAL REGISTRY.




